



## ICELAND

Sunday, October 8 to Friday, October 13, 2017

Join *And Away We Go Travel* for an adventure to Iceland. Here you will discover thundering waterfalls, hot springs, steaming lava fields, massive glaciers, thermal springs and volcanic landscapes. We are staying in one hotel located in Reykjavik, a city filled with shops, restaurants and nightlife. From here we will enjoy a fascinating journey exploring the spectacular highlights of this island nation.

**Sunday, October 8** We will be transferred to Logan Airport, Boston, and this evening will depart on our nonstop Icelandair flight to Reykjavik, Iceland.

**Monday, October 9** After an early morning arrival, our local tour director will meet us at the airport. Our day begins with a visit to a museum displaying the Viking Ship *Icelander*. We will be able to enjoy the exhibition as well as an included breakfast to regain some energy after our flight. We then continue with city sightseeing from the northernmost capital in the world, Reykjavik, where more than a third of Iceland's population lives. During this tour we will see the old town centre, the Parliament, the cathedral, the harbor, the Pearl, the National Museum and much more. The tour ends at our hotel, **Reykjavik Lights**. Our rooms may or may not be ready, so we can leave our luggage with the hotel and go off exploring Reykjavik. Dinner included.

**Tuesday, October 10** Breakfast included before an outstanding full day of touring the Golden Circle of southwest Iceland. Our tour includes three of the best-known attractions Iceland has to offer: Gullfoss (the Golden Waterfall), one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe; the Geysir Area with numerous hot springs and geysers; and Pingvellir, a remarkable geological and historic site. Pingvellir is the site of the world's oldest democratic parliament founded in 930. We return to Reykjavik at the end of the day. Dinner included this evening.

**Wednesday, October 11** Breakfast included. Today we will tour the south coast of Iceland, one of the country's most scenic regions, as far as Vik, a charming village surrounded by beautiful high bird cliffs. We will also visit Seljalandfoss waterfall where you can walk behind it and through to the other side, as well as visit the Skogar Folk Museum and see the black sand coastline and Reynisdrangar rock formations. We return to Reykjavik and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

**Thursday, October 12** Breakfast included. We have a mid-morning departure to journey to the famed Blue Lagoon, a unique geothermal spa located in the middle of a lava field. Relax in the warm, mineral rich water that is sure to rejuvenate the body and spirit. We will have the afternoon on our own for shopping or additional sightseeing in Reykjavik. Dinner included.

**Friday, October 13** After our included breakfast, time for last-minute shopping. Early afternoon departure to the airport for our nonstop flight back to Boston. After clearing customs and immigration, we will be transferred back to the Worcester area.

Tour includes: round-trip airfare via Icelandair nonstop flights; 4-nights accommodations at Reykjavik Lights Hotel; nine meals (five breakfasts and four dinners); sightseeing tours listed above; Blue Lagoon admission; round-trip transfers between the Worcester area and Logan Airport as well as roundtrip transfers between the Reykjavik airport and hotel; gratuities for luggage handling and tour guides on the tours. Travel insurance is highly recommended.

Days of sightseeing tours are subject to change. Temp. average: 46 degrees daytime and 39 at night.
